PAPERWORKS WORKSHOP SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Scholarships to workshops are available for all PaperWorks members. The artist should make a written request via the PaperWorks Scholarship application form and present or send the application to the Board. The application should state their reason for requesting assistance, indicating their desire to make advancement in their work, and a willingness to share their experience with fellow PaperWorks members.

The application must be made to the Board at least two months prior to the workshop requested. As workshops can fill fast, it is best for the applicant to reserve their place in the workshop by making the required deposit as soon as possible. If the scholarship applicant is not awarded the scholarship and as a result cannot attend the workshop, then they will be reimbursed for the full amount of their workshop deposit.

The scholarship may be awarded for up to fifty-percent (50%) of the total of the workshop cost and supply fee.

A member may apply and receive a scholarship once every other year.
