

Barbara J. Lewis Study Grant Program 2009

The Barbara J. Lewis Study Grant Program has been created to expand the understanding and appreciation of handmade books.

The program is open to PaperWorks members in good standing (dues paid) who wish to pursue some aspect of the book arts, either through independent study or by formal instruction. Examples might include: courses, workshops, or private tutorials

One grant will be awarded. The grant will pay for no more than **50% of incurred costs and will not exceed \$200** for the year 2009. The grant will be funded after completion of the member's study and verification of the costs incurred.

Applications must be received by the Barbara Lewis Trust Fund Committee on or before June 1, 2009. Selection of the recipient will be by the Committee based strictly on the proposal that best meets the goals of the grant program. Announcement of the recipient will be made at the meeting.

An invoice for reimbursement of expenses must be submitted no later than December 15, 2009. While it is hoped that the recipient might choose to share newly gained knowledge with the PaperWorks membership, this is not a requirement of the grant.
